


Micro-CHP Sales in 2005



Note: Micro-CHP defined as 5-kWe and below






Japanese Market





Japan by 2010

- Established micro-CHP markets
 - ECOWILL
 - Genelight
- More products
 - Fuel cells (PEM and solid oxide) several thousand units sold?
 - Stirling engines introduced?
- Strong gas utility marketing
 - Battle with electric utility promotion of all-electric homes



Europe by 2010

- Steady growth for 5 kW products
 - But not mass markets for these products
- 1 to 3 kW products introduced
 - Internal combustion engines (Honda + others?)
 - Stirling engines
 - Rankine cycle engines
 - Fuel cells?
 - Pico-turbine?
- Mass market development critically dependent on:
 - Utility involvement
 - Boiler manufacturer actions



North America by 2010

- Gradual growth for Honda/Climate Energy unit
- Possible (limited) introduction/demonstration of
 - Stirling engines
 - Rankine cycle engines
 - Fuel cells



What to Watch in the Next Three Years

- Fuel cells in Japan
- Utility and boiler manufacturer actions in Europe
- Policy and regulation in Europe
- New product introduction (Stirling engines, Rankine cycles)
- Changes in utility / HVAC manufacturer / policy in North America
