WOC4 – members

- 82 members joined WOC4, from all over the world:

- Europe: 47
- Asia: 18
- Latin America & Caribbean: 6
- CIS: 5
- North America: 3
- Asia Pacific: 2
- Africa: 1

WOC4 – the Questionnaire

A web-based questionnaire has been prepared and circulated in the Distribution industry around the world.

- Survey year: 2010
- 56 responses received from 24 different countries



WOC4 – the Questionnaire

Questionnaire information was gathered from companies that operate gas networks that:

- serve a total of more than 116 million customers (+36% comparing triennium 2006-2009)
- manage 1.9 million km of gas mains (+36% comparing triennium 2006-2009)
- European region accounts for 52% of the data gathered
this influences the results of the survey, but we must always consider that the questionnaire is an input to the work and not the output itself
