Background and review of initial co-operation actions

- late 1990s: decision by Indian Government to import LNG
- in 1997 : creation of a special purpose company, Petronet LNG Limited, mandated to create LNG terminals in India
- in 1997 : GDF selected as strategic partner, then equity partner
 - GDF supplemented PLL with the skills in cryogenics and LNG.
 - GDF expatriates brought their operating experience, commercial expertise and design and engineering skills
- PLL can trust GDF at every step of the project, from preliminary design to operation







Background of Gaz de France (GDF)

- Since 1965, GDF was operating LNG terminals with success and total availability of its 3 LNG terminals in Le Havre, Fos and Montoir,
- zero personnel or materiel accident in operation,
- zero damage to third parties or impact on neighboring).
- GDF pioneer, with the involvement in the first ever commercial LNG chain between Arzew, Algeria and Europe

- Based on that experience, ELENGY was able to make a good practice and transfer it to PLL.
- Nothing is really revolutionary, but the global picture gives a solid frame for safe operation on the technical aspects











Conclusion: toward co-operation

Knowledge is the key to success, and here we have people who work together to turn that key, opening new doors and new markets.

The Technical service agreement was a way:

- to stay on the side of PLL, and not at the place of PLL,
