City Tour in São Paulo

On a bus and walking tour we will meet some interesting places in São Paulo:

Mercado Municipal de São Paulo: this walking tour will satisfy food lovers. Lots of fruit stall selling all sorts of wonderful types of fruit, wonderful nuts, olives, cheeses, vegetables and oils. Famous for its deep fried cod pasties.

Páteo do Colégio: in this place a school was built in 1554 by the Jesuit brothers, who founded Sao Paulo. Part of the original wall of the first building is preserved, can clearly see the construction technique. The cafe in the Anchieta Museum is a very nice place, where you can enjoy the true Brazilian coffee.

JK Iguatemi Shopping: the newest luxury shopping in Brazil is located in São Paulo. There are over 200 shops, 30 restaurants and cinema 4D. The venture is the first fully integrated with the shopping environment, where architecture and technology investment are examples of a fully sustainable shopping. Built with high efficiency windows, natural light is exploited by reducing energy consumption. Another highlight is the roof, made of eco-friendly material, which reduces the impact of the sun's rays, making the temperature pleasant.

<u>Masp Museu (distant half an hour from hotel) m</u>: MASP, Museu de Arte de São Paulo Assis Chateaubriand, was opened in 1947 by Assis Chateaubriand and Pietro Maria Bardi. The site includes a collection considered the most important in the Southern Hemisphere with Brazilian and foreign artists in a collection that spans the 19th century to the 20th century. Examples include The Resurrection of Christ, Raphael Sanzio, and the Virgin and Child and Saint John the Baptist Child of Sandro Botticceli - Renaissance copies. Masters such as Van Gogh, Manet and Degas are also present. The Spanish art has painters such as Velázquez, El Greco and Goya. Entrance: R\$15,00 per person; Address: *Av. Paulista*, 1578 - Opening hours on Thursdays from 11h00 to 20h00.

<u>Mac Museum (very near to hotel)</u>: One of the most important museums of modern and contemporary art from Latin America, the Museum of Contemporary Art USP was established in 1963. Its collection has about 10,000 works, including paintings, drawings, prints, photographs, sculptures, objects and works of conceptual art and contemporary art. The list of artists includes Picasso, Matisse, Miró, Kandinsky, Modigliani, Calder, Braque, Henry Moore, Tarsila do Amaral, Di Cavalcanti, Volpi, Flávio de Carvalho, Julio Plaza, Antonio Dias and Regina Silveira, among many others. Address: *Avenida Pedro Álvares Cabral*, 1301-*Ibirapuera*; Free Entrance; opening hours: from 10h00 to 18h00.

<u>Ibirapuera Park (very near to hotel)</u>: Ibirapuera Park is the largest urban park in the city of São Paulo, Brazil. It was inaugurated on August 21, 1954 to commemorate the fourth centenary of the city. The park has a bike path and thirteen lighted courts, and jogging tracks intended for walks and rest, all integrated into the cultural area. Its area is 1.584 km², and its three artificial and interconnected lakes occupy 15,700 m². Address: *Avenida Pedro Álvares Cabra*l, gates: 02, 03, 04, 09 e 10 (from 5am to 22h00)
