

Turkmenistan: the fourth largest world gas




Global gas demand (IGU/IHS CERA 2012 study)






Gas share of the global primary energy consumption (IGU/IHS CERA 2012 study)





Natural gas and LNG trade by region 2010-2035 (Bcm/year) Source: IEA






Major pipeline gas and LNG trades in 2012






