

Growth in primary energy demand - by region




Global energy demand increases by one-third from 2010 to 2035,






Coal demand by country in Asia 1970-2035






Regional distribution of conventional gas reserves 1992- 2012






Major trade flows of natural gas and LNG 2012



Two main pipeline projects in South Asia






Market based pricing of gas in three main consuming regions



Natural gas prices in Asia, Europe and the USA






Regasification capacities in Asia-Pacific 2000-2017


