






IEA forecasts continuing dependence on fossil fuels in the future

- Increasing competition for energy security particularly to secure the long-term supply of oil and natural gas.







Gas Supply-Demand Balance by Regions







Increasing Inter-dependency between Gas Producers and Consumers

- Russia, Iran, Qatar and Turkmenistan are the top four countries having the largest gas reserves.
- Increasing dependency of gas consuming countries in Europe and Asia from these gas supply centres.
- Respecting interdependency between gas producers and consumers are important.


