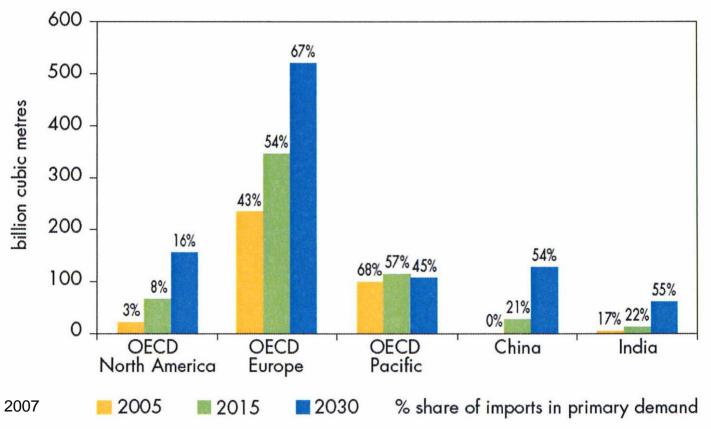




Import dependency is increasing

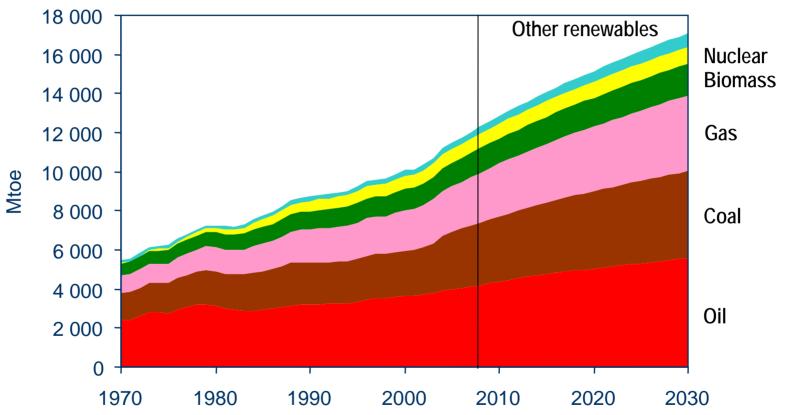

IEA forecasts growing gas demand in the future





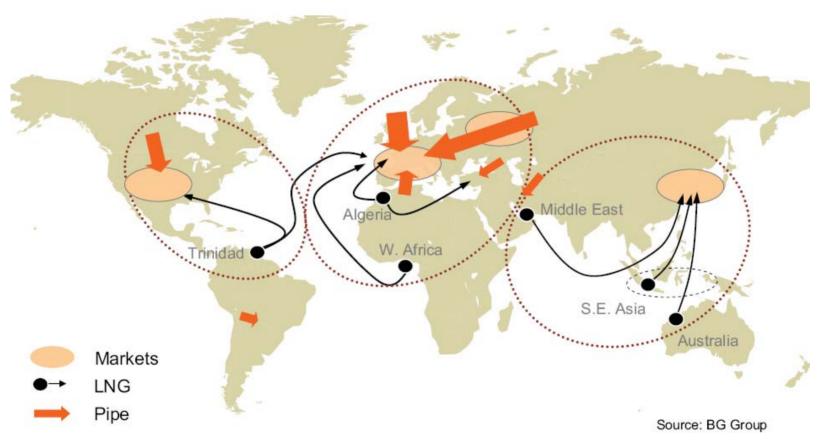

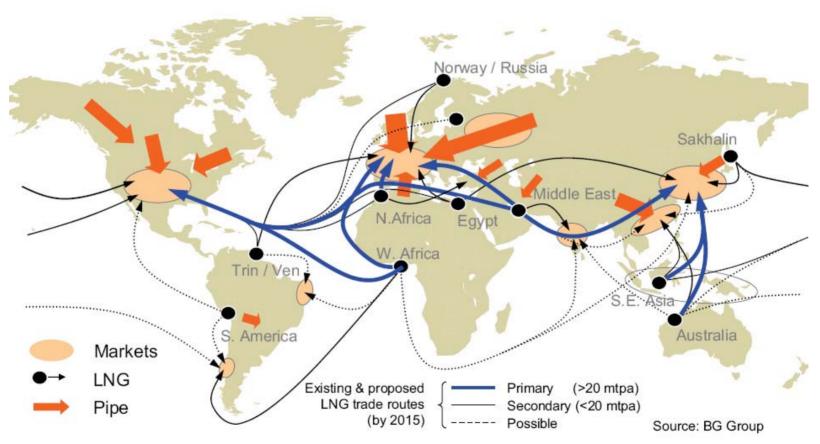

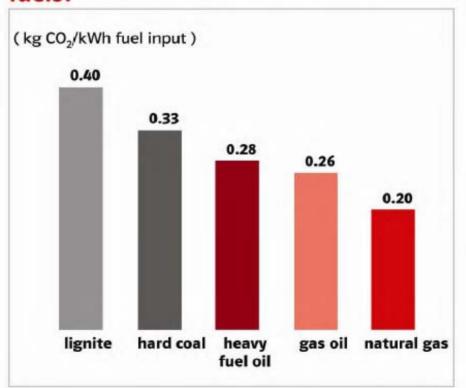




Natural gas – lowest carbon content

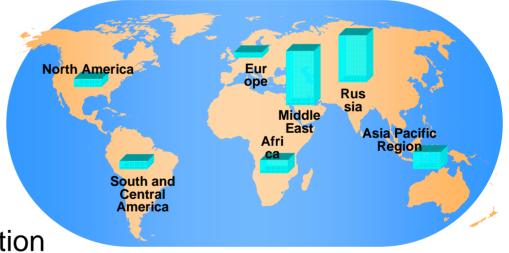


Access to new reserves

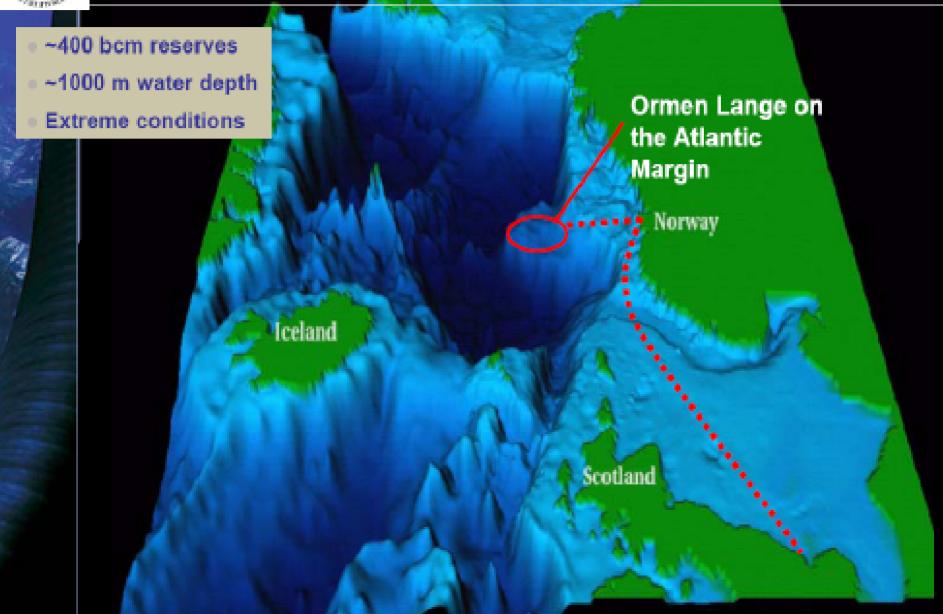

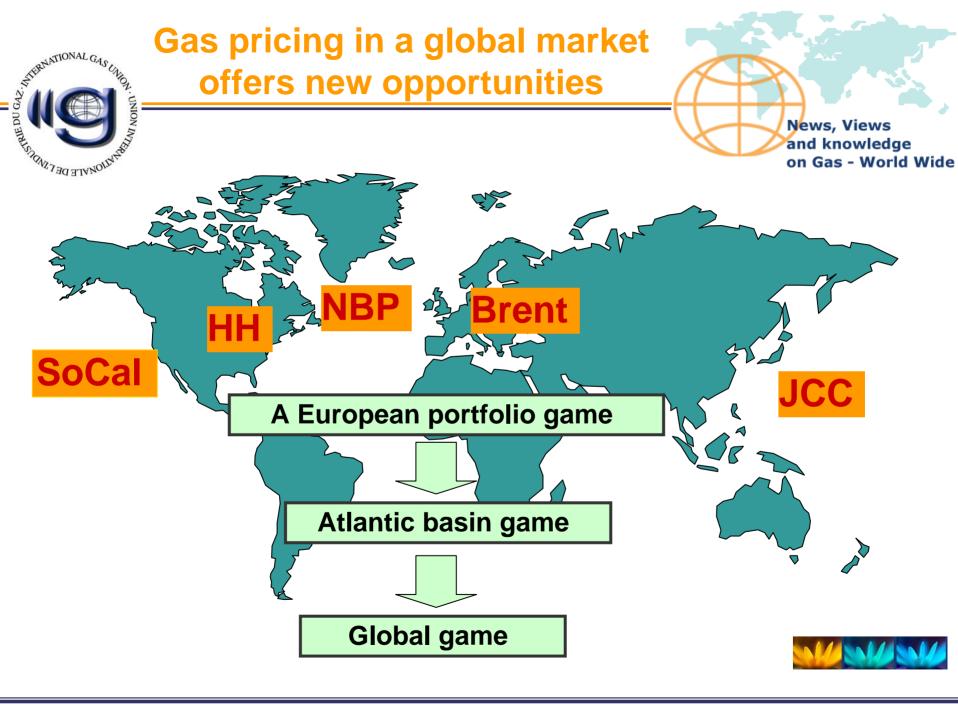
