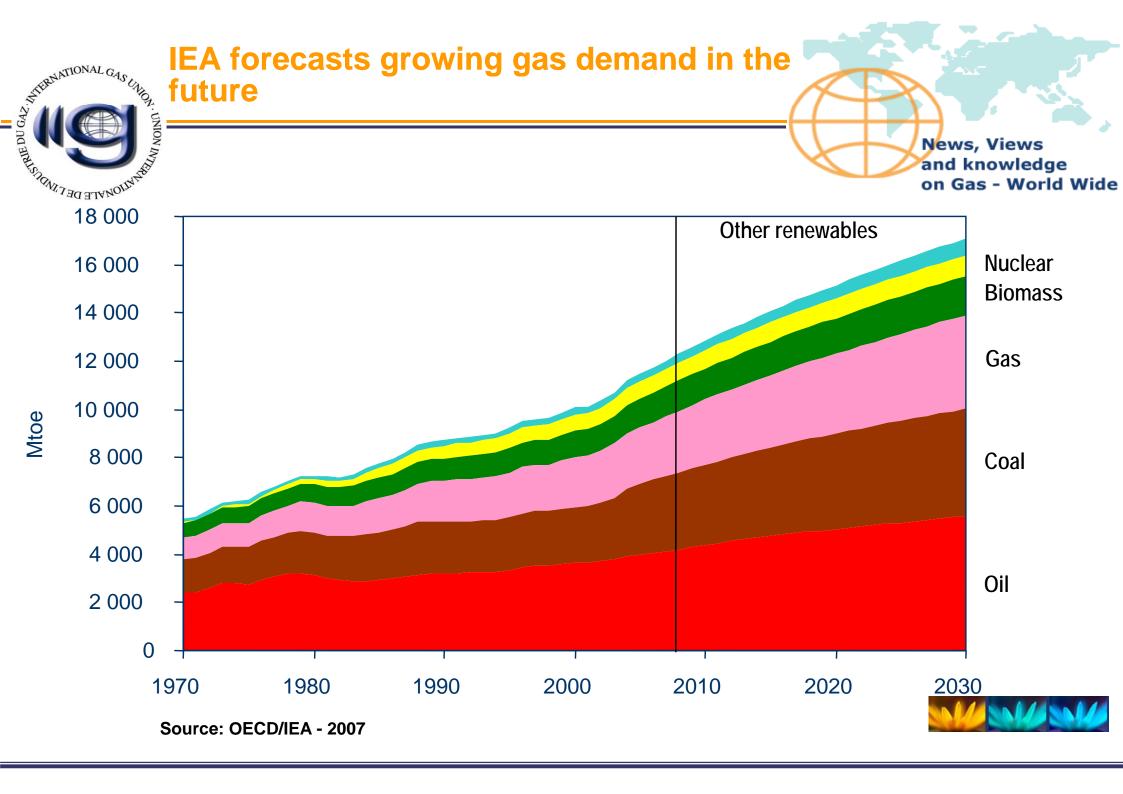


"Safe Forecasting"

- Fossil fuels will dominate next decades

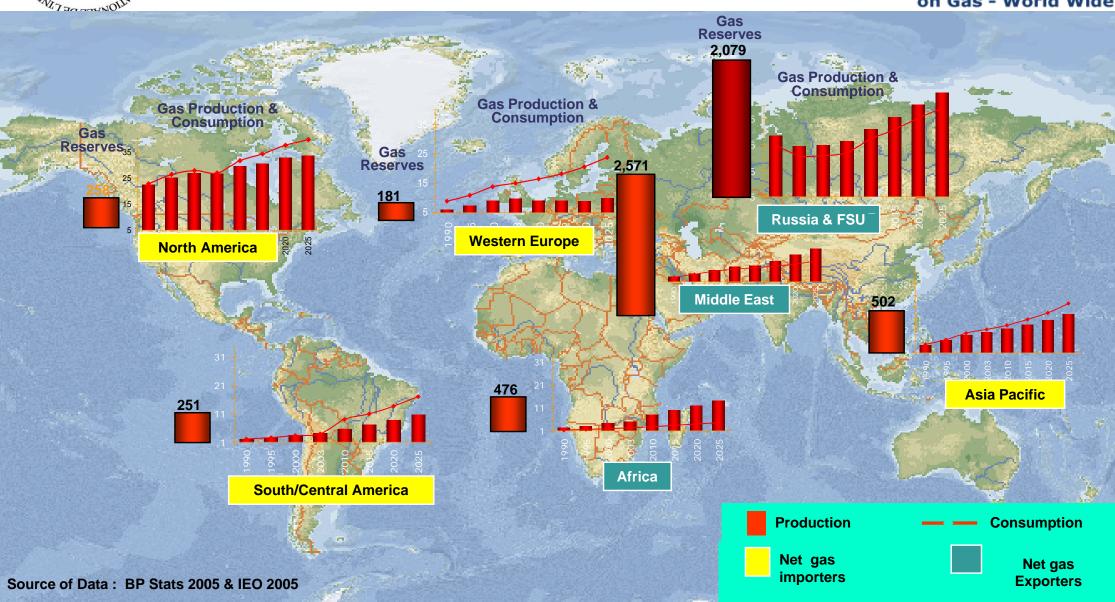




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Natural gas reserves are primarily located in Russia & FSU and Middle East, rather far from the gas demand centres

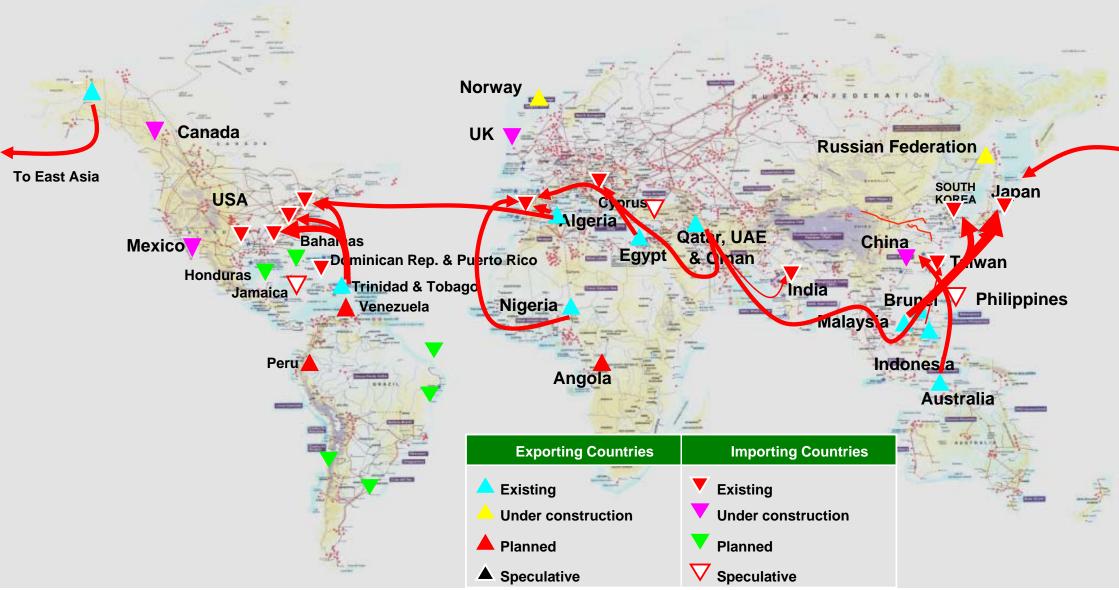

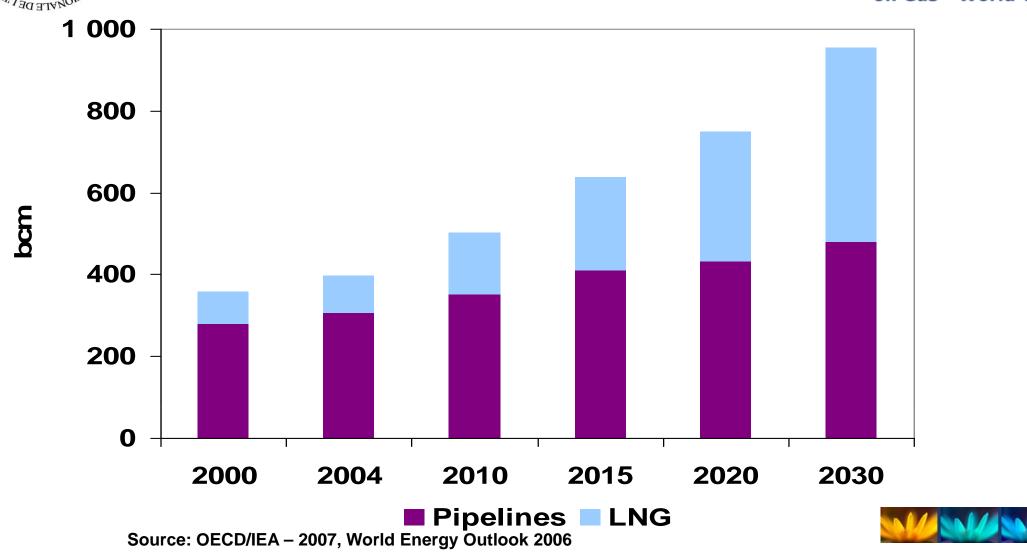
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LNG capacity is catching up



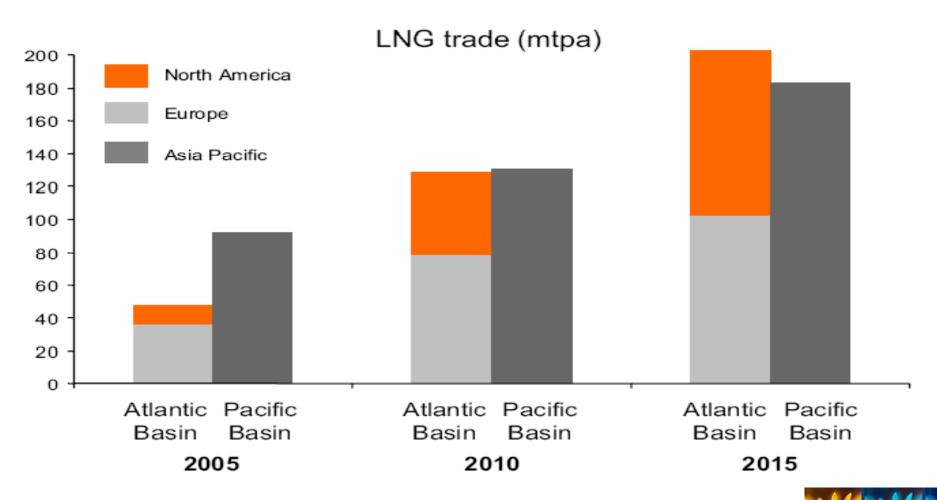


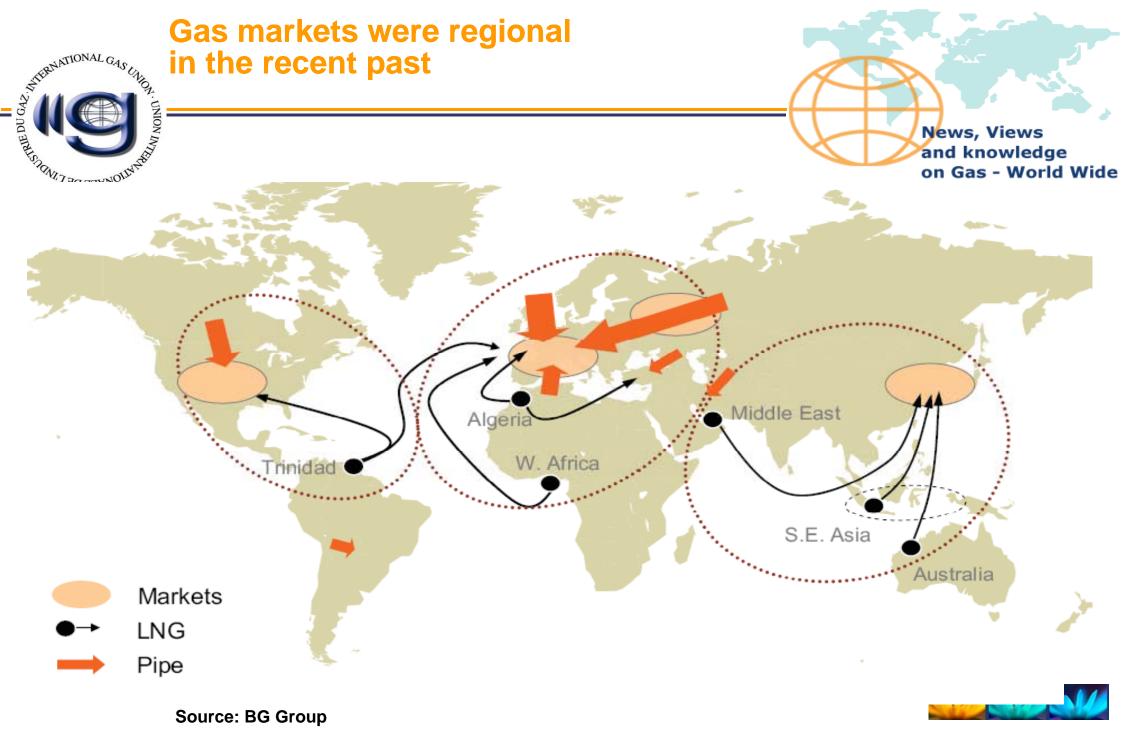


LNG Capacity forecasted to grow

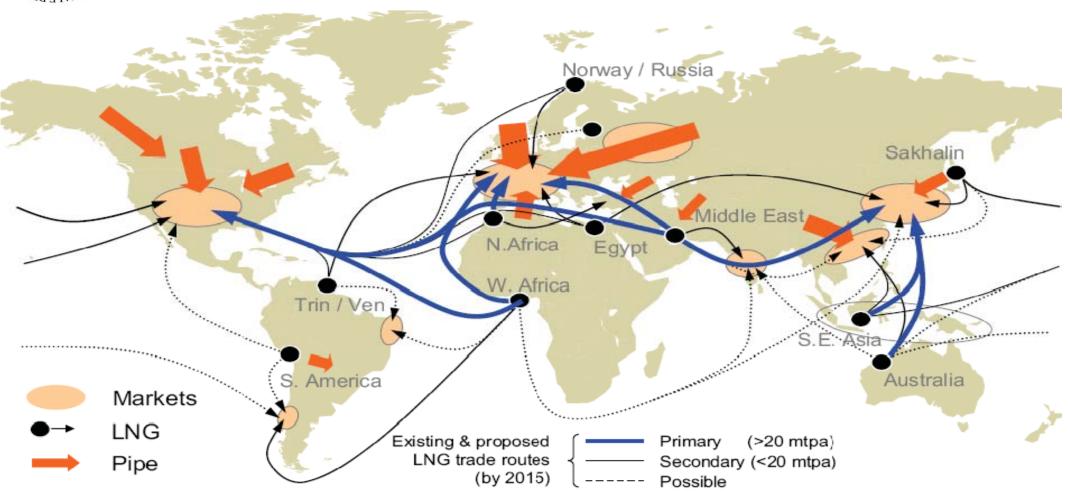






A global gas trade is evolving

- US is emerging as the balancing market

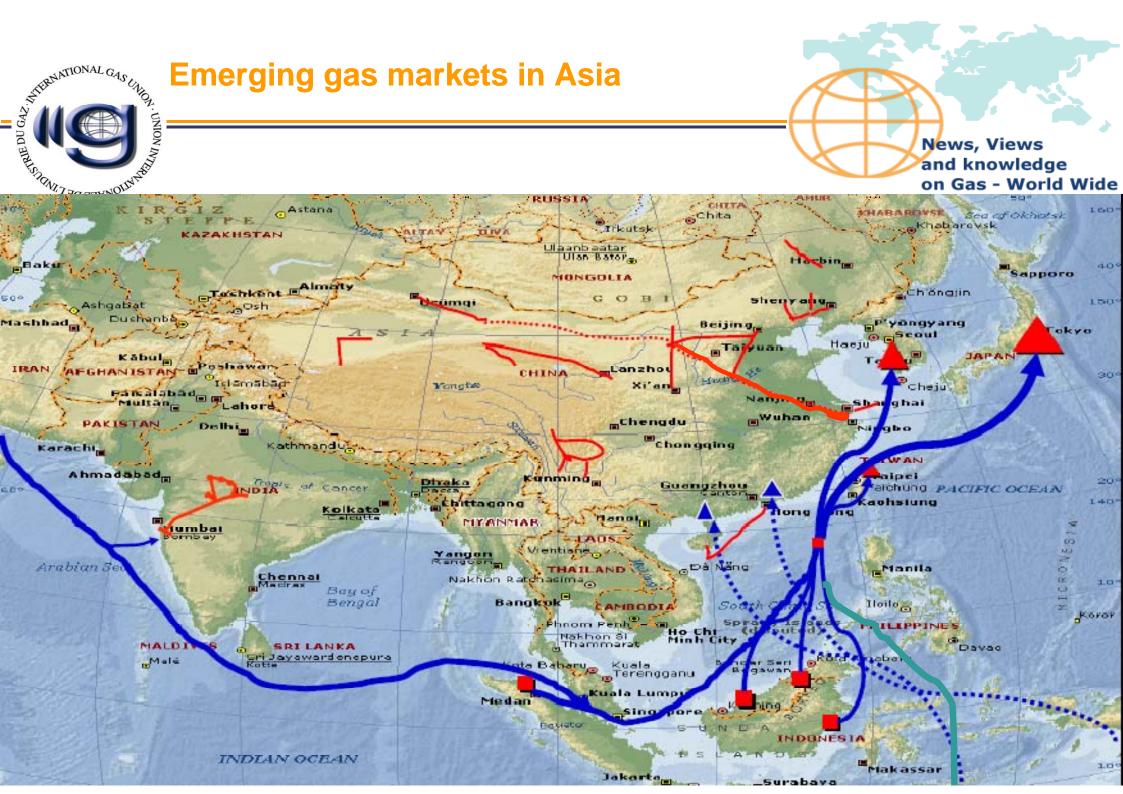


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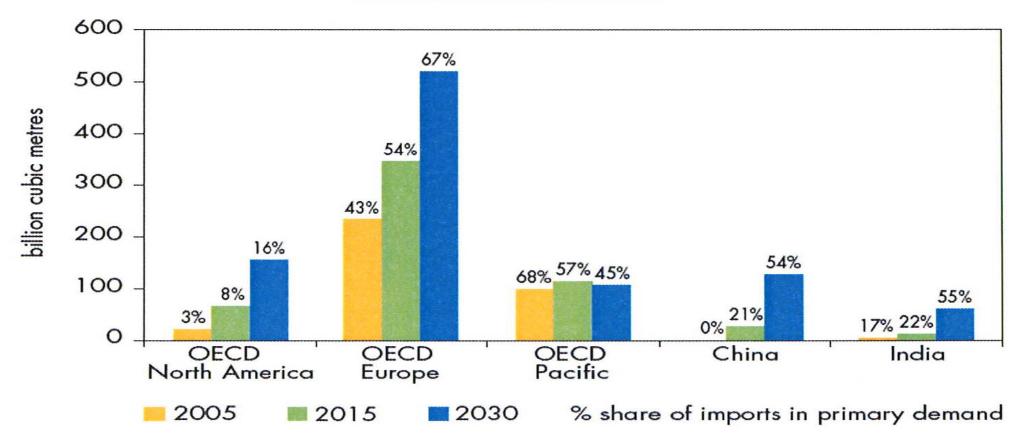




Import dependency is increasing in most regions by 2030



Net Imports of Natural Gas by Major Region in the Reference Scenario





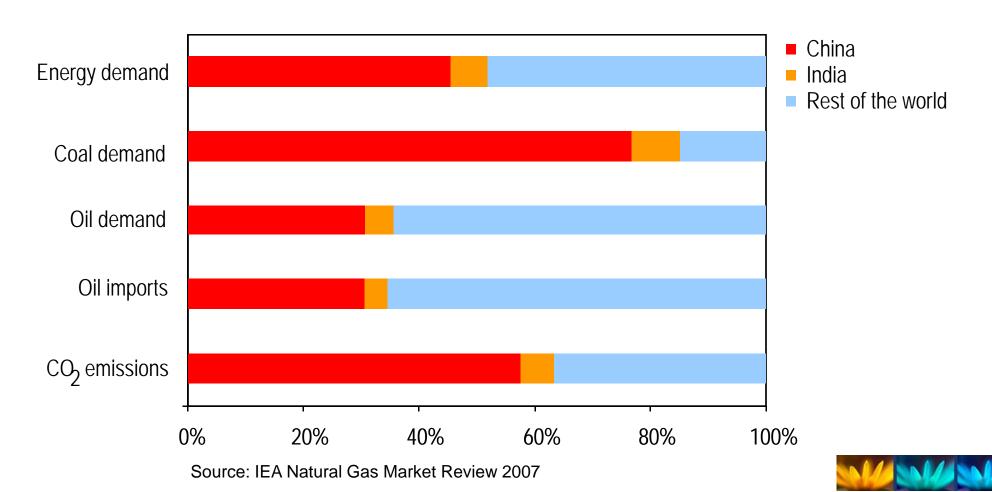

Increase in World Primary Energy Demand, Imports & Energy-Related Gas - World Wide CO₂ Emissions in the Reference Scenario, 2000-2006





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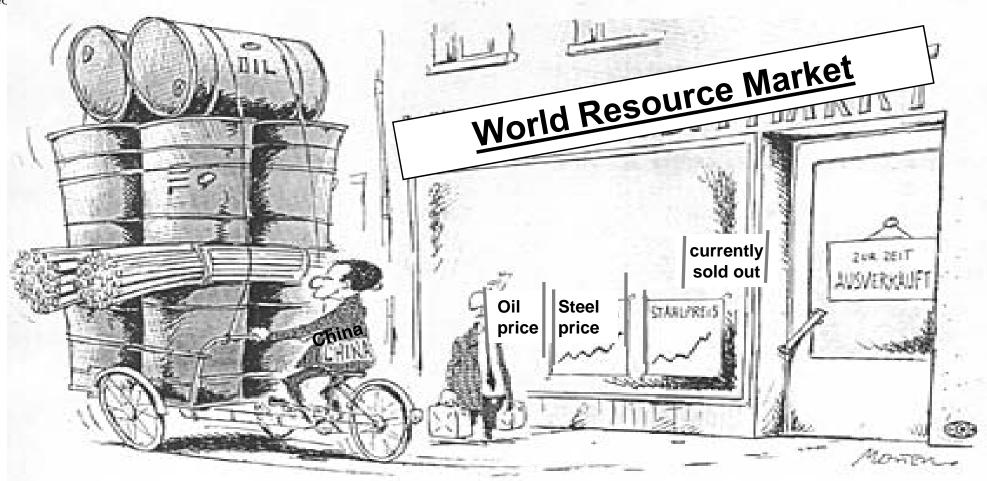

- Absence of transit countries along the supply route



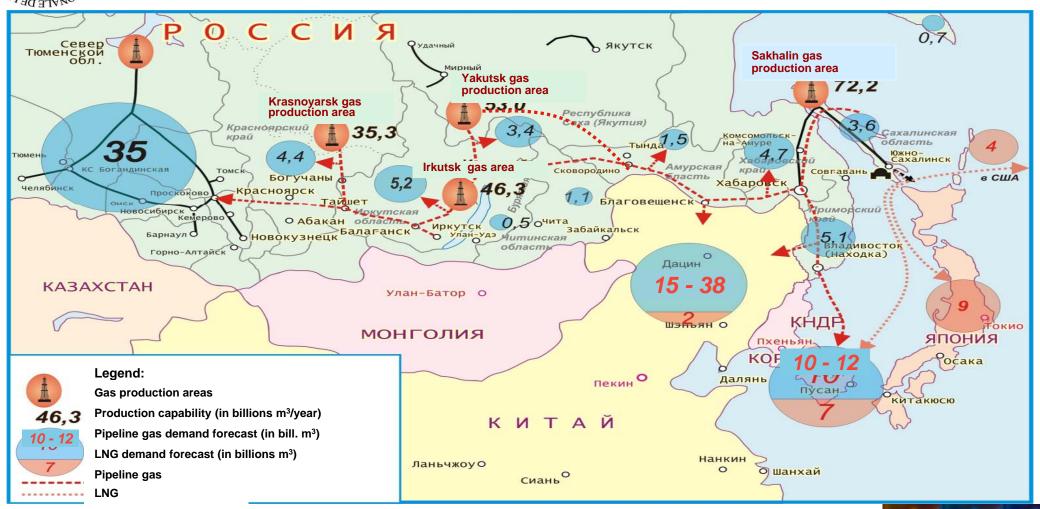




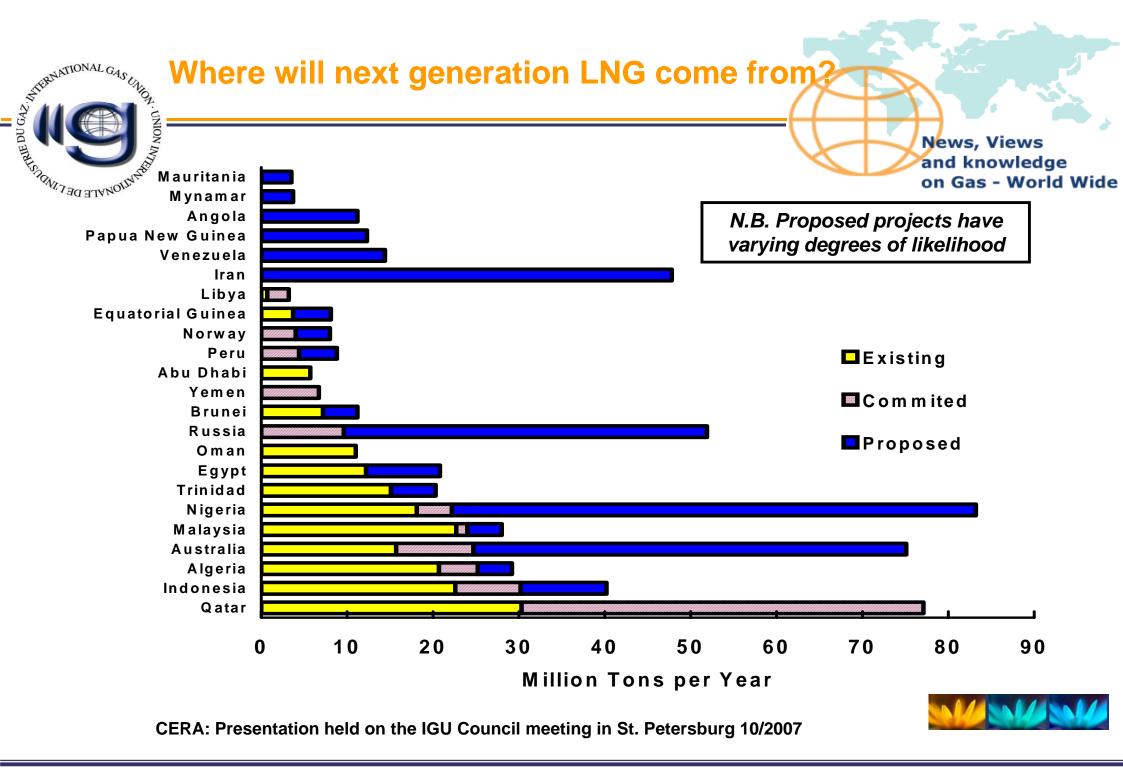
