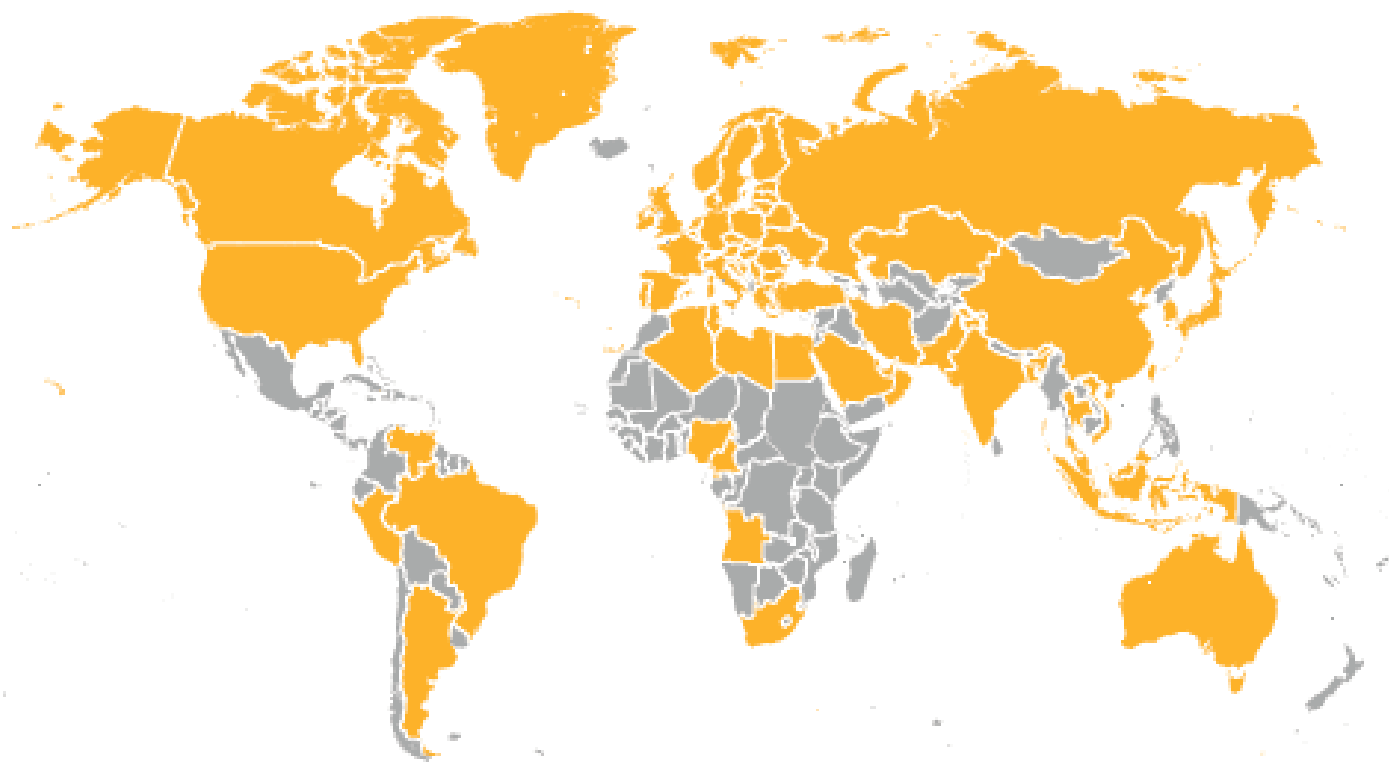

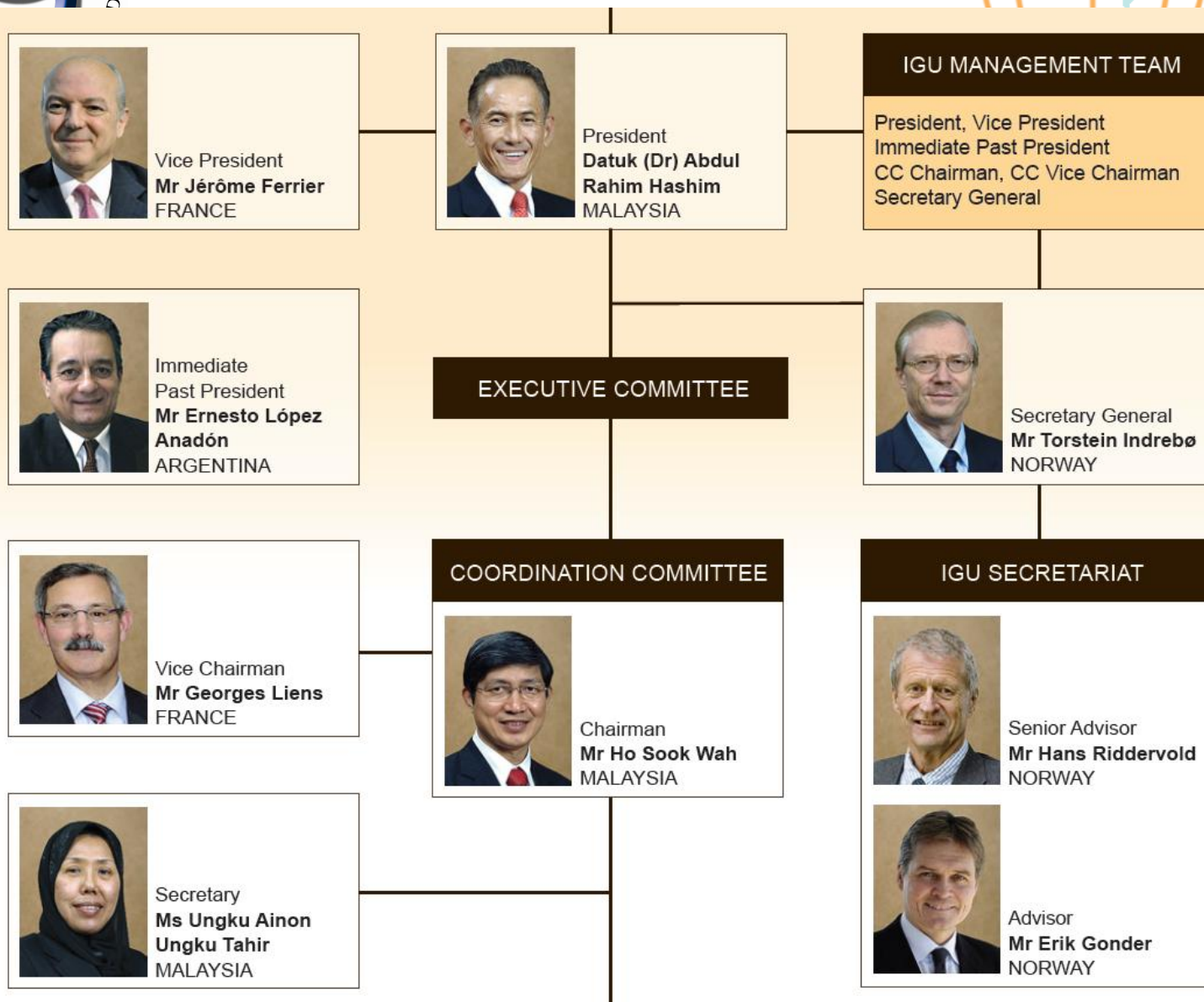

# IGU Organisation Chart 2009 - 2012

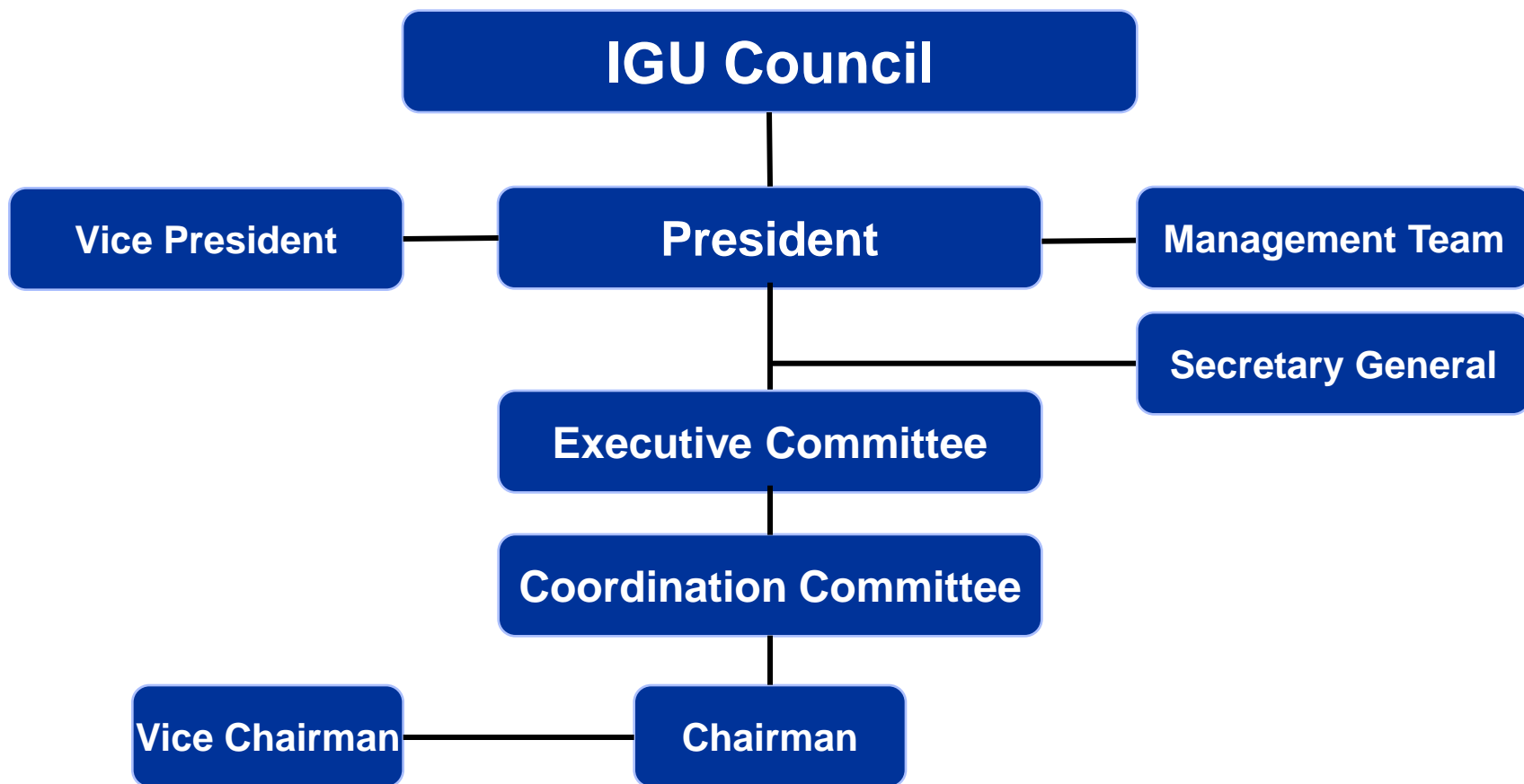
