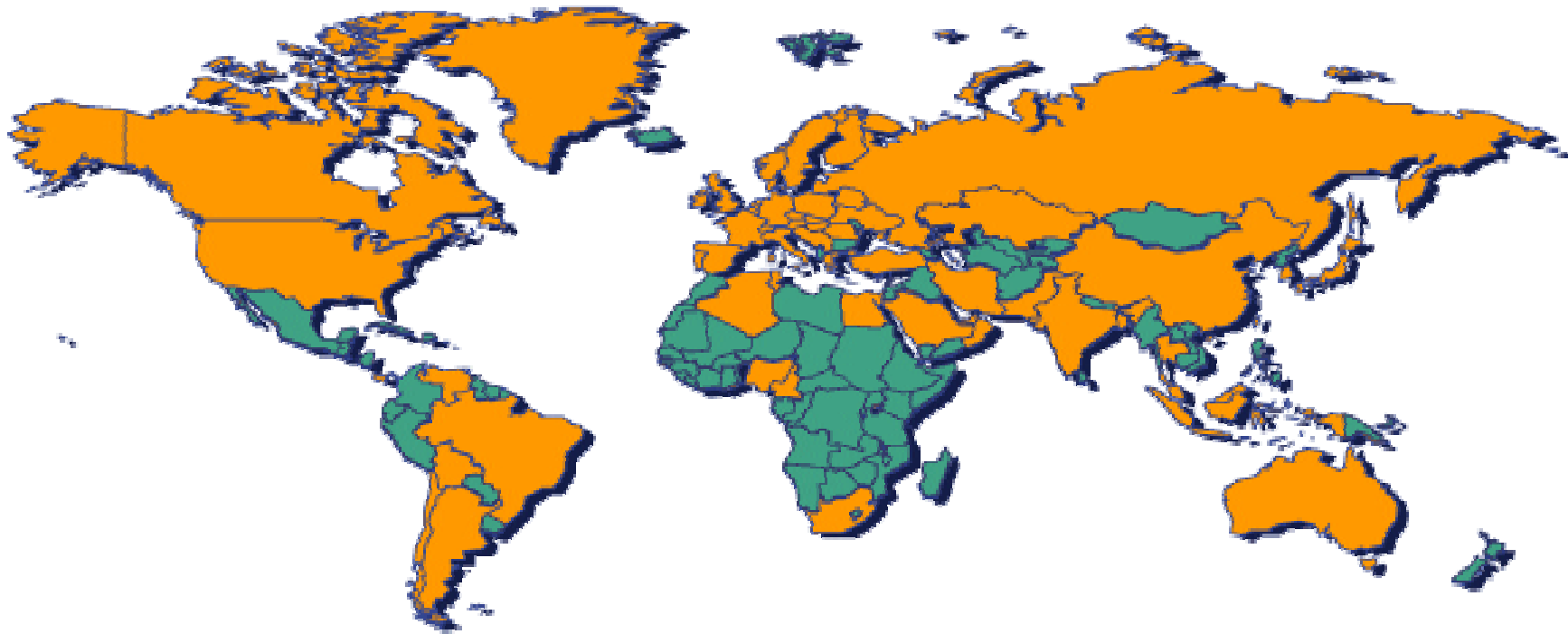


Membership

- **Charter member (max 1 per country):**
 - normally Association but also Company or Gas department of Energy companies and the like
 - Voting rights in all IGU bodies
- **Associate member (max 9 per country):**
 - Any other gas entity if it contributes to IGU and owns assets related to the gas chain
 - May apply for charter membership after three years, may if applicable challenge existing charter member
 - Approval by the Council
 - 3 Associate members have voting rights in EXC

- **In carrying out this mission, IGU will maximise value to its members and to gas customers**

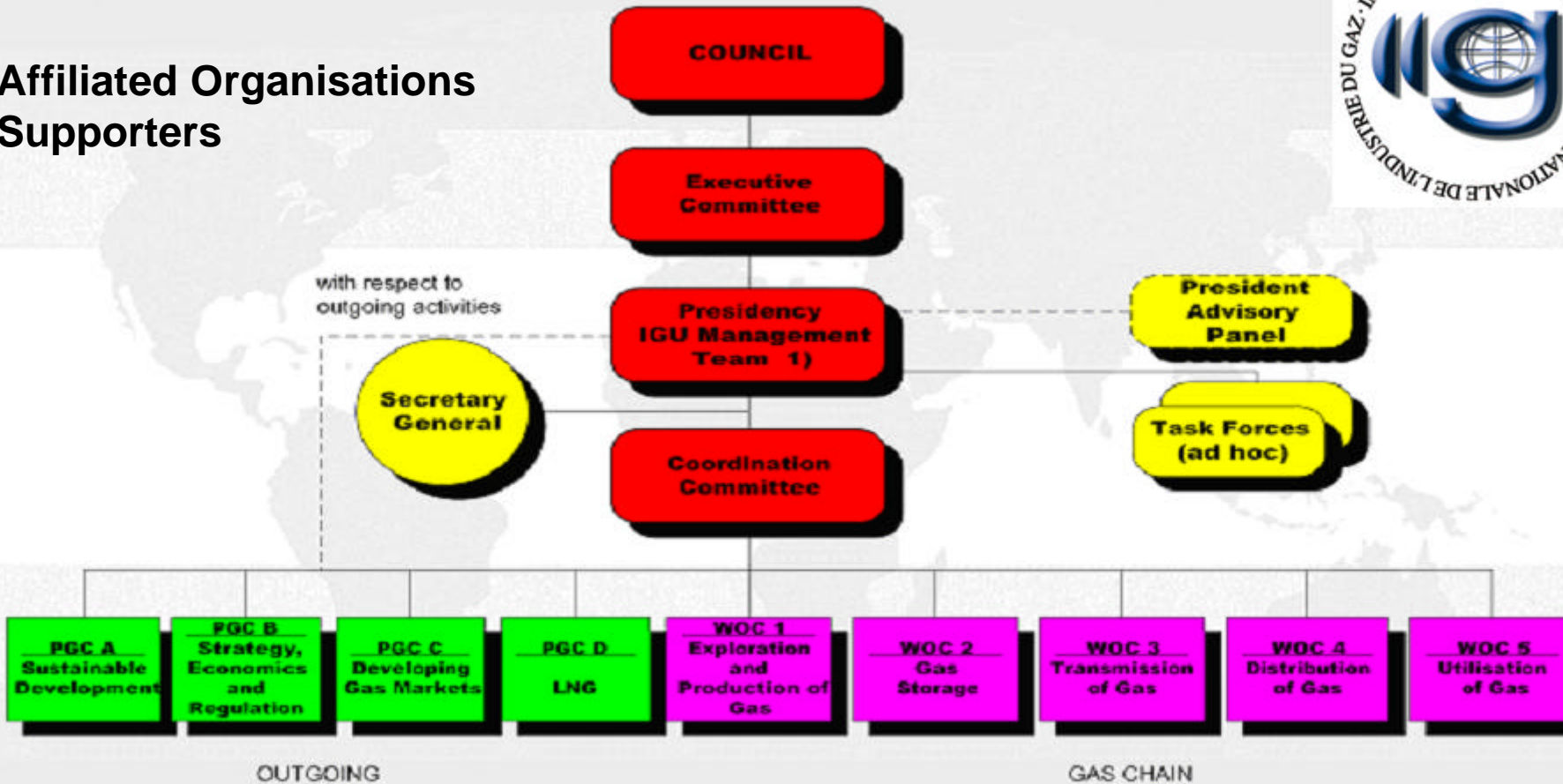


INTERNATIONAL GAS UNION Organisation from June 2003

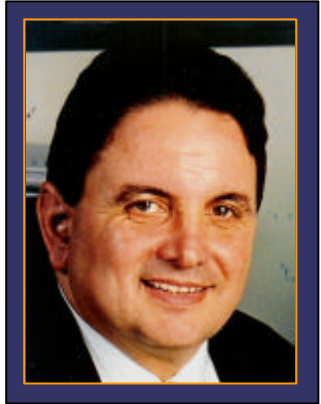

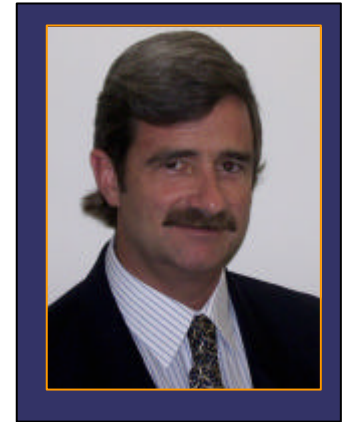

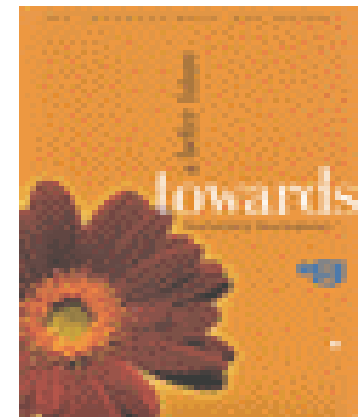
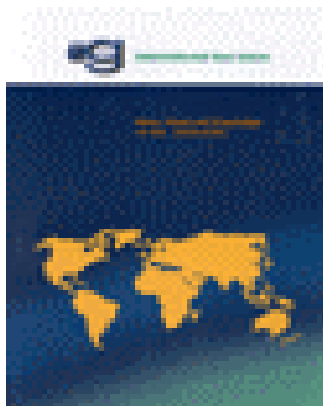
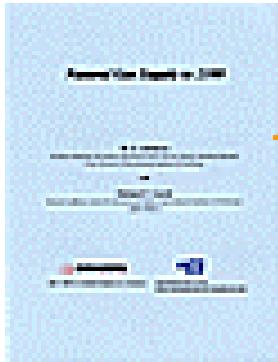
- **Initially produced and distributed/sold by the host country**
