INVITATION TO IGU'S 6TH PGC-C MEETING – PORT-OF-SPAIN, TRINIDAD

This time we have arranged for guests to stay at the recently refurbished Hilton, Trinidad Hotel and Conference Centre, known as the world's only upside down hotel. Nestled on the hillside, the Hilton Trinidad offers panoramic views of the host city of Port-of-Spain.
