





Timing of sessions



Thematic Session: 90'

A Chair (and a VC of session, that could present the report) is proposed by the Group, the CC will confirm.

- Presentation of the report of the subgroup: 10 to 15'

- •The debate and Q&A with the room will be organised by the chair: 45' minimum






