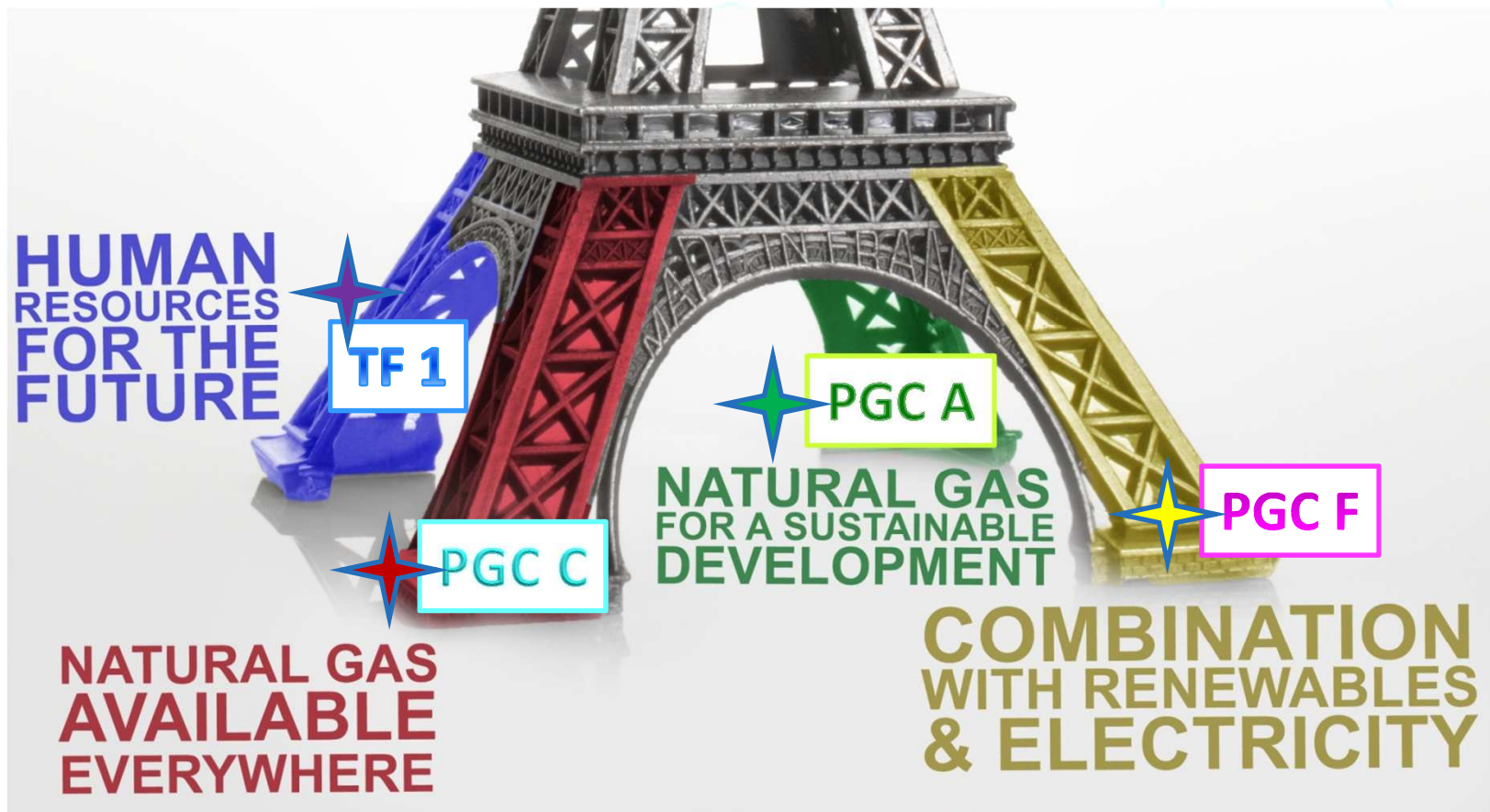

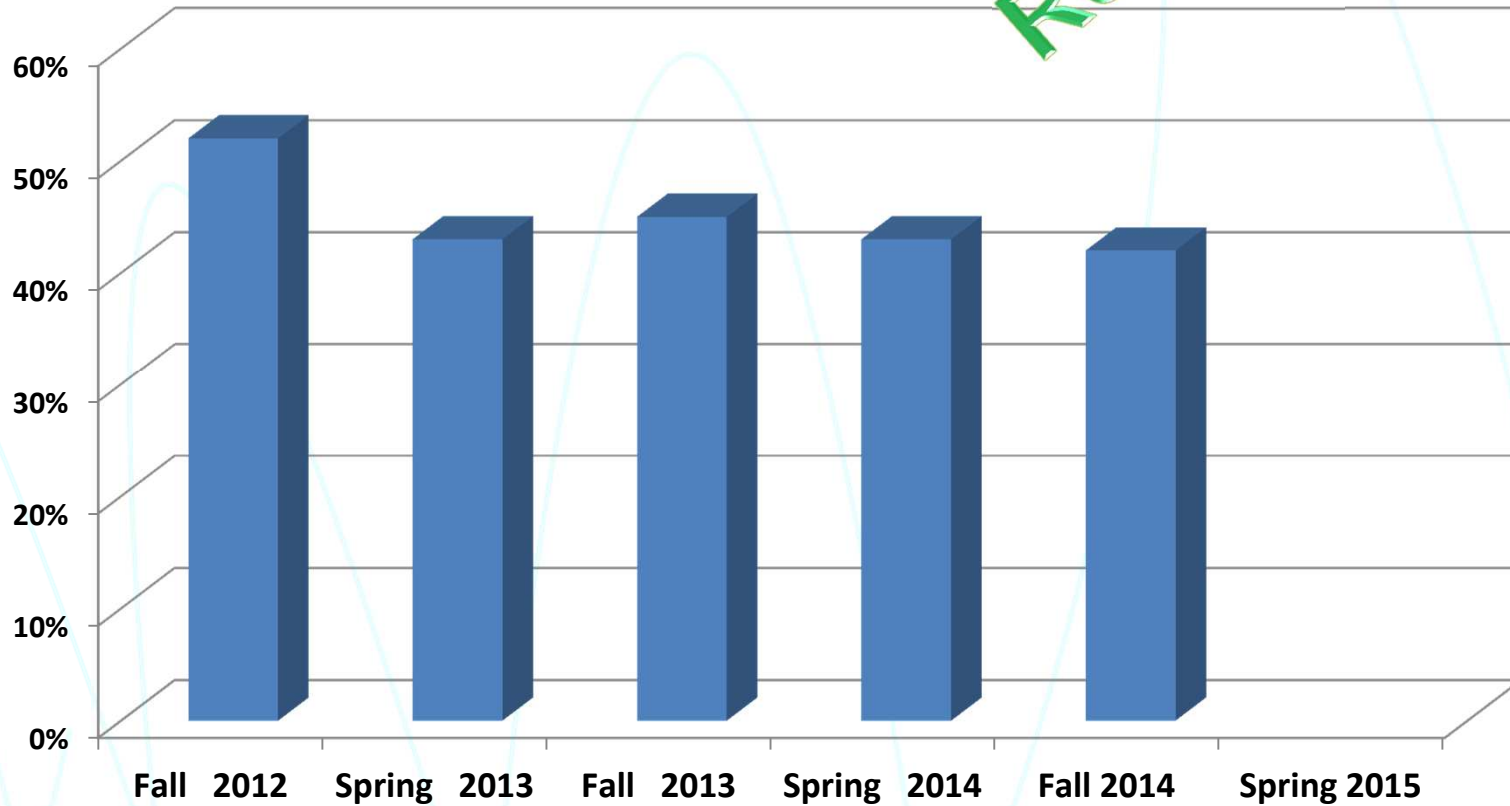

Timing of sessions

Thematic Session : 90'

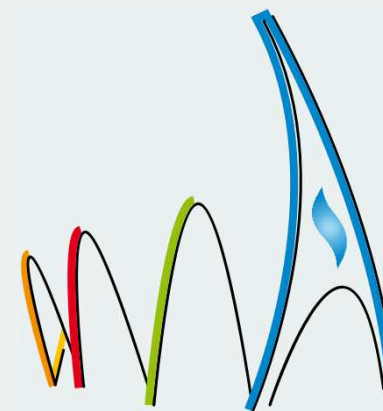

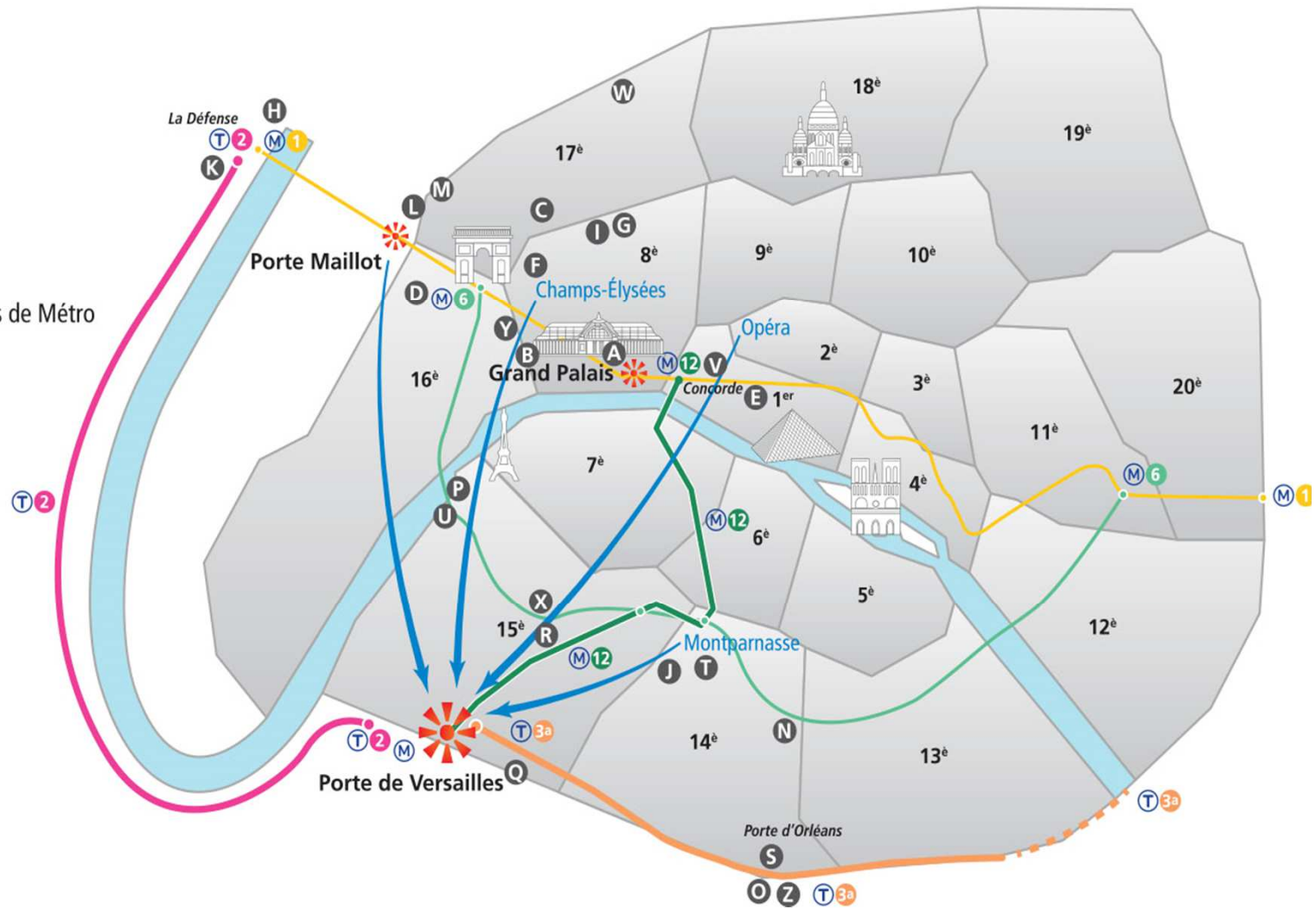


WGCPARIS2015 PARIS GENERAL MAP

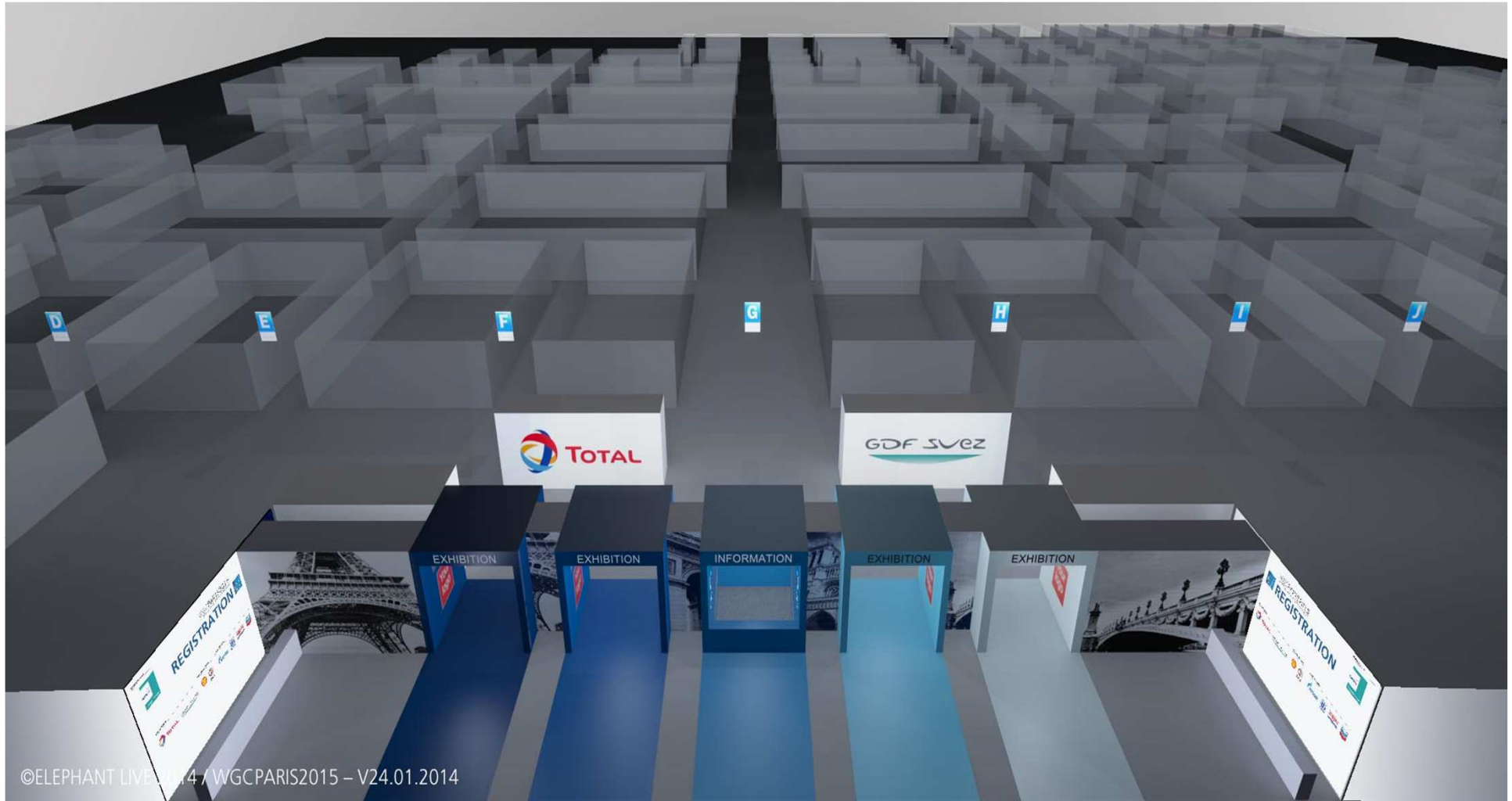

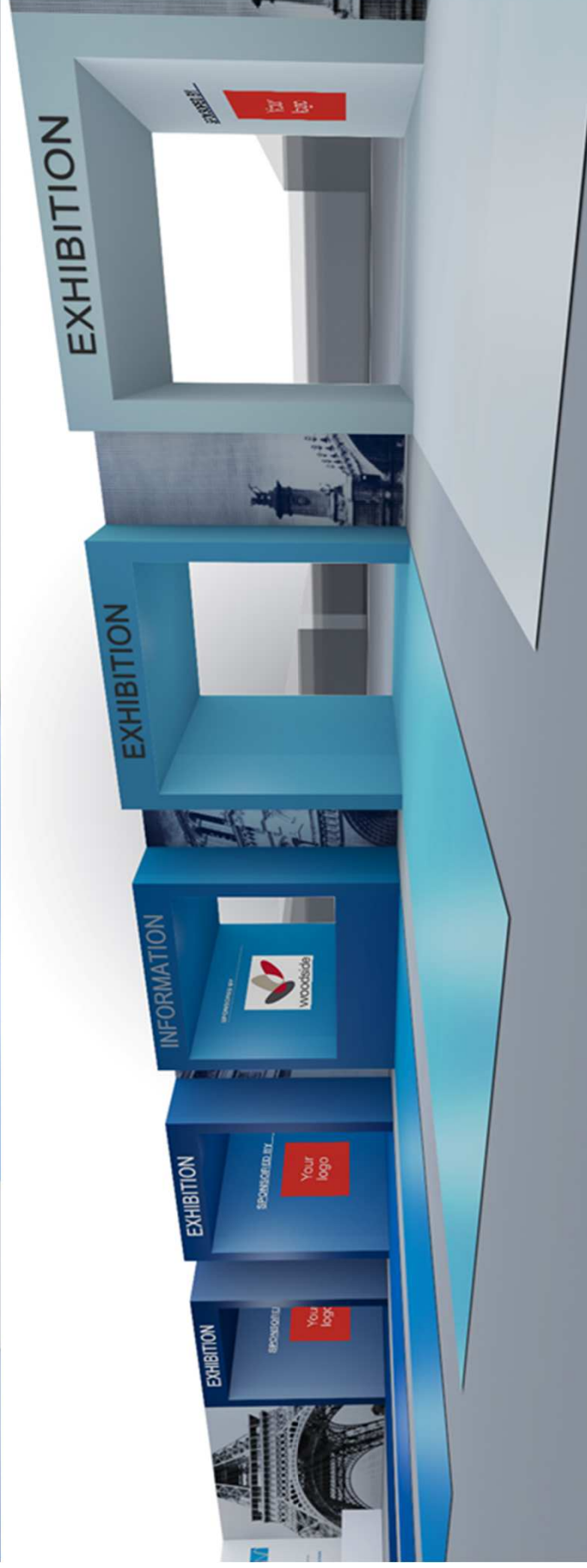
