Gas Transmission Operator GAZ-SYSTEM S.A. is a strategic company for the Polish economy, responsible for natural gas transmission across the country.

By the end of 2014, GAZ-SYSTEM S.A. plans to build about 1,000 km of new gas pipelines throughout Poland. The development of the gas pipeline network in Poland may constitute an important element of the North – South Gas Corridor joining the LNG terminal in Świnoujście with the planned Adria LNG terminal and with the Nabucco gas pipeline with the aid of the internal transmission infrastructure of Central European countries.

The company has also started up the new Polish - Czech Interconnector.

GAZ-SYSTEM S.A. also holds the company Polskie LNG S.A., set up to build and operate the liquified natural gas (LNG) terminal at Świnoujście.

The terminal is being constructed at Swinoujscie near Szczecin in the western part of Poland's Baltic coast.

The Swinoujscie LNG terminal is scheduled for completion by the end of 2014.

The new terminal is expected to initially receive 2.5 billion cubic metres of liquefied gas. By 2017 or 2018 will be ready to receive 7.5 billion cubic metres of gas.
