

- Each Thematic Session will be 90 minutes long. There will be 10-15 minutes for the
 presentation of the report, up to 6 authors presenting for between 7-10 minutes, and then
 15 minutes for Q & A.
- Each Interactive Session will be 45 minutes long with 10 minute introduction from the session leader. Each author then has 5 minutes to present. There can then be 5 minutes for questions at the end of the session.
