- In 1992 Czech Gas Association followed up on the diverse activities of its predecessors, who had founded the Czechoslovak Gas and Water Association in Czechoslovakia as early as 1919 and co-founded the International Gas Union (IGU) in 1931.
- CGA currently brings together roughly 100 trade associations and companies operating in the gas industry and almost 300 individual members, most of them preeminent gas experts.



- CGA represents the Czech Republic in the International Gas Union and participates in its activities
- CGA represents the Czech Gas Companies in Marcogaz, Eurogas, ENGVA, ISO, CEN... and participates in its activities
- CGA represents the Czech gas industry in the drafting of international and national legal and technical regulations



- Total natural gas consumption (2013): 8,27 million m3










#### FIGURE 33: SHARES OF BALANCE RESPONSIBLE PARTIES IN GAS CONSUMPTION IN CR 2013








- Natural Gas Distribution System length reaches 72 708 km (incl. local grids) with pipelines till DN 700 and PN 40
- In total 9 underground storages with the capacity ca 3,5 bln m3 (depleted gas/oil fields, cavern storage or aquifer storage)





- world unique high pressure unlined rock cavern gas storage in Haje:
- **√** Tunnels 45 km
- ✓ Volume 620 000 m³
- Daily capacity 9 mil.m<sup>3</sup>
- 12,5 MPa maximal pressure
- Water sealed concrete barriers with special pressurized well

# **Gas Utilisation Support**





- 56 CNG large stations in 2.Q/2014
- 100 CNG stations in 2015
- 7000 NGV's in 2.Q/2014
- 22 mil. m3 CNG total consumption in 2013
- rapid development of a CNG consumption
- + 41% in 2013 (compared to 2012)
