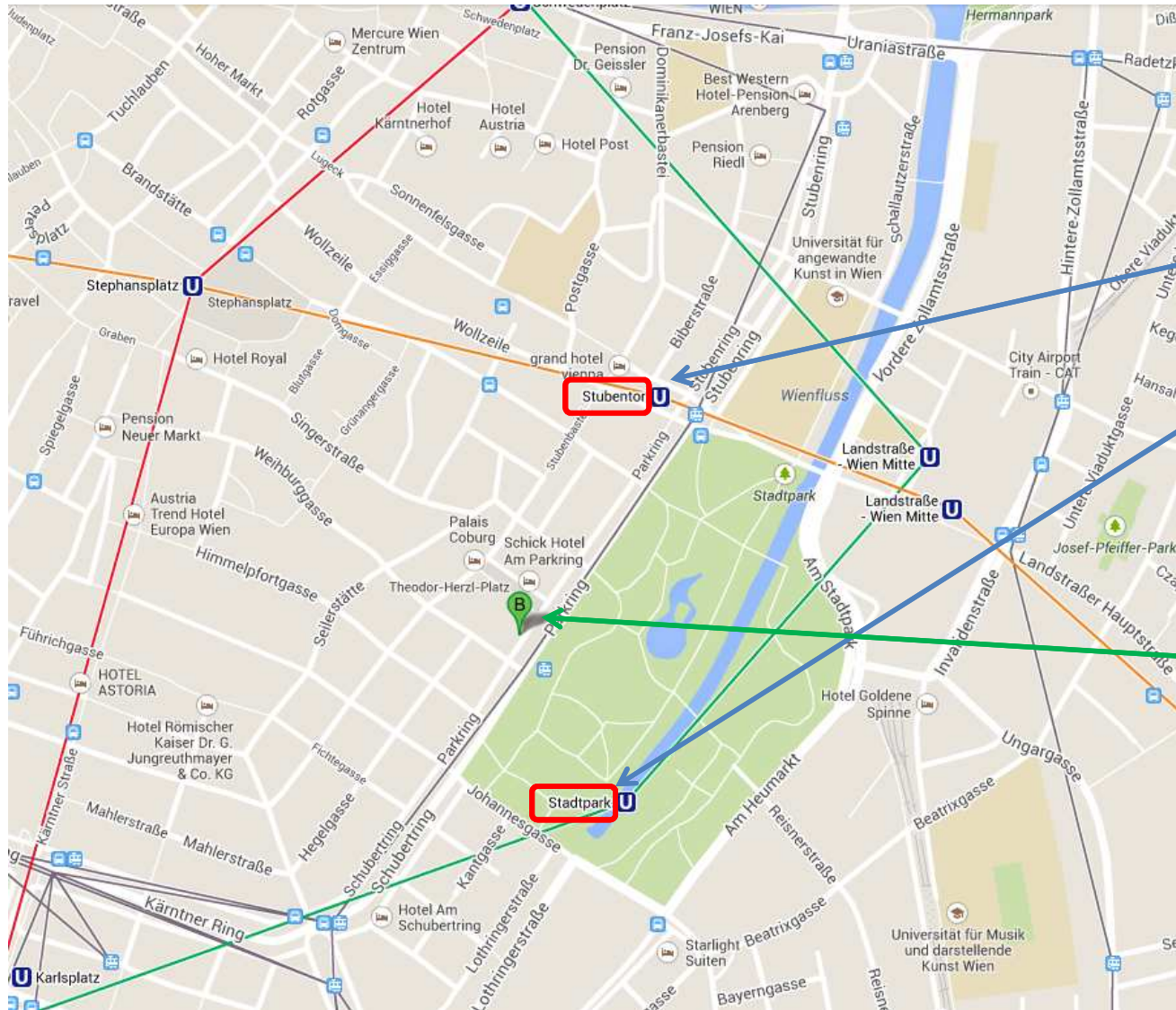

## Schloss Schönbrunn Schönbrunn Palace

The former summer residence of the imperial family, is one of Europe's most impressive Baroque palace complexes. Famous from the Sissi movies, **Schönbrunn Palace** and its **Baroque park** as they appear today were built and remodelled during the reign of Empress Maria Theresa from 1743. Today this palatial complex, which was declared a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site in 1996, is one of **Vienna's finest attractions**.

## Hofburg Vienna Hofburg

Until 1918 the extensive palatial complex at the heart of Vienna was the political centre of the monarchy. Today it fulfils the same role for the democratic Republic of Austria. The rooms where once Emperor Joseph II drew up his revolutionary programme of reforms, where the Congress of Vienna met and danced and where Emperor Franz Joseph held audiences, now house the offices of the Federal President, the ministers of the chancellor's office and the secretaries of state.

St. Stephen's Cathedral**

St. Stephen's Cathedral was severely damaged by fire in the last days of the Second World War and virtually reduced to rubble. But with seemingly everyone lending a hand, the cathedral was rebuilt in just seven years: the emblem of Austria and symbol of Austrian identity had risen once more from the ashes. You can climb up St. Stephen's Cathedral (South Tower, Türmer Stube), take the lift up to the Pummerin (North Tower), or go down into the catacombs.



**Spanische Hofreitschule  
Spanish Riding School**

The Spanish Riding School in Vienna is the only institution in the world which has practiced for over 440 years and continues to cultivate classical equitation in the Renaissance tradition of the haute école. The objective of classical equitation is to study the way the horse naturally moves and to cultivate the highest levels of haute école elegance the horse is capable of through systematic training. The result creates an unparalleled harmony between rider and horse, as only Vienna's Spanish Riding School achieves.

## **ALBERTINA Museum**

The Albertina is one of the most frequented museums of Austria and a highlight for all visitors of Vienna. It is the objective of its tourism department to offer decision-makers in the travel industry information and support so that every visit to the museum will become a complete success.



## **Hundertwasserhaus**

The Austrian artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser started out as a painter. Since the early 1950s, however, he increasingly became focused on architecture, writing manifestos and essays and undertaking demonstrations, in which for instance in 1958, he read out loud his 'Mouldiness Manifesto.' In 1972, he had his first architectural models, which he used to visualize his ideas on forested roofs, tree tenants and window rights. In these models he developed new architectural shapes, such as the eye-slit house, the terrace house and the high-rise meadow house. In lectures at academies and before architectural associations, Hundertwasser elucidated his concerns regarding an architecture in harmony with nature and man.
